You will be working directly with our small Philanthropy and Partnerships team of five, undertaking a varied range of tasks including research, writing, communicating with supporters, producing materials and providing administrative support where needed.

What you can gain from the role:

- You will gain an insight into the work of an ambitious, high impact global health advocacy organisation, and specific experience in charity fundraising and partnerships with a focus on institutional funding and corporate partnerships
- A chance to develop your research, writing and workplace skills including use of Salesforce.
- The opportunity to play a role in the global movement to help end malaria deaths.

KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

These will vary according to the needs of the team but are likely to include:

Researching potential partners, supporters and opportunities using information gathered through desk-based research and telephone enquiries.

Analysing and providing insight to qualify potential funding partners, through discussion with team members and desk-based research.

Where necessary, helping to prepare reports and/or

proposal documents for funders and partners.
Supporting the team in building and tracking progress of a pipeline of funding approaches.

Offering general administrative support to the Philanthropy and Partnerships team, including data entry and helping with correspondence.

PERSON SPECIFICATION – What skills will you have?

- You will be comfortable paying close attention to detail and will have accurate data entry skills - experience using a contact database (particularly Salesforce) would be of benefit although training will be provided.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills; being able to articulate clearly on the phone and face to face as well as in writing.
- You will enjoy and have experience with conducting quality research using a range of different sources of information and thinking laterally about possible opportunities for Malaria No More UK.
- You must know how to use Microsoft Office programmes, in particular Word and Excel. PowerPoint would also be a particular advantage.

What type of person will you be?

- Detail-oriented and comfortable with processes, quick to spot mistakes in both written work and spreadsheets.
- Well organised and reliable with a willingness to "muck-in".
- Capacity to deal with sometimes unstructured and unpredictable environments.
- Enthusiastic about our mission and about your future in international development or a possible career in fundraising.
- A lived malaria experience is a plus
